It wasn't long ago that dogs roamed freely in Roslyn. In fact, it still happens from time to time. And these days, you are also likely to find chickens scavenging for bugs not far from their backyard coops in every corner of town. The Roslyn Library's **Friend or Fowl Exhibit** will feature art depicting or relating to dogs and chickens, either individually or together. Acceptable mediums include oil painting, watercolor, photography, decorated eggs, sculpture, even mini-architecture - tiny chicken coop, anyone?

Submission Criteria and Guidelines

- Submissions must include the means to display the art. Two dimensional art must include hanging or standing hardware. Three dimensions must be free-standing or include a display stand and be no more than 3 cubic feet.
- Submissions must be accompanied by a signed submission form.
- Artists may submit up to 3 pieces.
- The Roslyn Library may not be able to display all submissions and the library is responsible for all final display decisions.
- Artists will assume all liability for their submitted works.
- Artists are responsible for picking up their items at the end of the exhibit.
