March 24, 2007 Tryouts and Draft**

Attention Rookie, Minor & Major Baseball and Softball:

Again this year all UKC Youth Baseball and Softball teams, except T-Ball, will be assembled through a draft system. Those remaining in the same division as last year(ie, Major Divisions) are not required to participate in the tryouts and will not be part of the draft system. These players will remain on the roster of their last year's team. All players moving up from a lower division or players who did not participate in our Association last season will be required to attend the tryouts. The coaches from each division will evaluate each player's abilities. During the draft process players will be selected and assigned to a team roster.

Tryouts for all divisions will take place at the Cle Elum High School from 9:00 am – 2:00 pm on March 24th 2007. The players will run through several drills both inside the gym and outside on the football field. Please dress appropriately and bring your baseball glove. **(SEE SCHEDULE BELOW).**
